

# Spring Musical - CURTAINS – March 11-13

We are proud to be the first high school in the county to produce this new musical, which just finished its run on Broadway in 2008. (You may remember that David Hyde Pierce – aka “Niles” from Frasier – won the Tony award for his lead role as the detective in this show.) The famous team of John Kander and Fred Ebb, creators of hit shows *Chicago* and *Cabaret*, are responsible for the music and lyrics for Curtains as well.

Curtains is a musical comedy whodunit that tells the tale of a group of producers and performers involved in a Boston performance of *Robbin’ Hood of the Old West*. There is a show within the show - trying to win the approval of audiences for their production to be the next Broadway smash. However, on opening night, the leading lady is murdered during her curtain call. Lieutenant Frank Cioffi of the Boston PD, a big fan of musical theatre, is called in to solve the case, while the cast and crew try to revamp the production to make it a success.

**All seats are reserved on a first-come basis.** Anyone wishing to be seated together should order tickets on the same form, naming one person as a main contact. We will do our best to accommodate requests for seats in a specific location – you may indicate any preferences below.

**Why order tickets in advance?** You’ll reserve your seats - since all tickets reflect assigned seats in the auditorium. You’ll save time - by not having to wait in ticket lines on show nights. You’ll save money – tickets purchased on show nights will cost \$6 for students, and \$8 for adults, so you’ll save \$1 on each ticket reserved before March 10<sup>th</sup>.

Advance ticket orders will be processed immediately upon receipt, so the “best” seats will be reserved early. Please use a separate order for each performance. Actual tickets will be available approximately two weeks prior to performances, and can be delivered to you by a cast or crew member if you wish, or returned to a PM student. You may also opt to have your tickets held at the door. Doors will open for seating 30 minutes prior to showtime.
