

MYTHOLOGY FINAL PROJECT

Your job is to research some element of mythology and share it using the presentation software on our computers. You can choose to research a single character (god, goddess, demigod, hero, beast) OR an idea that you come up with (the creation of fire, the underworld...) The idea of this research is purposefully open ended. Some suggestions for what you should include:



- Greek/Roman name
- Where do they come from (who are their parents)
- What is their area or domain of influence (god of fire, goddess of love, etc.)
- What are their qualities, strengths, or talents? (superhuman power, can change forms, etc.)
- What personality traits or flaws do they have? (very jealous, fall in love with everyone, greedy, etc.)
- What is one interesting story about the character? Describe it.

You will have a total of four class periods to work on this project. Below is an outline of the class periods you have. Please estimate the amount of time you feel you will need for research, planning out your project, and using the computer to create your final project.

Some suggestions: for 4th, 5th and 6th graders:

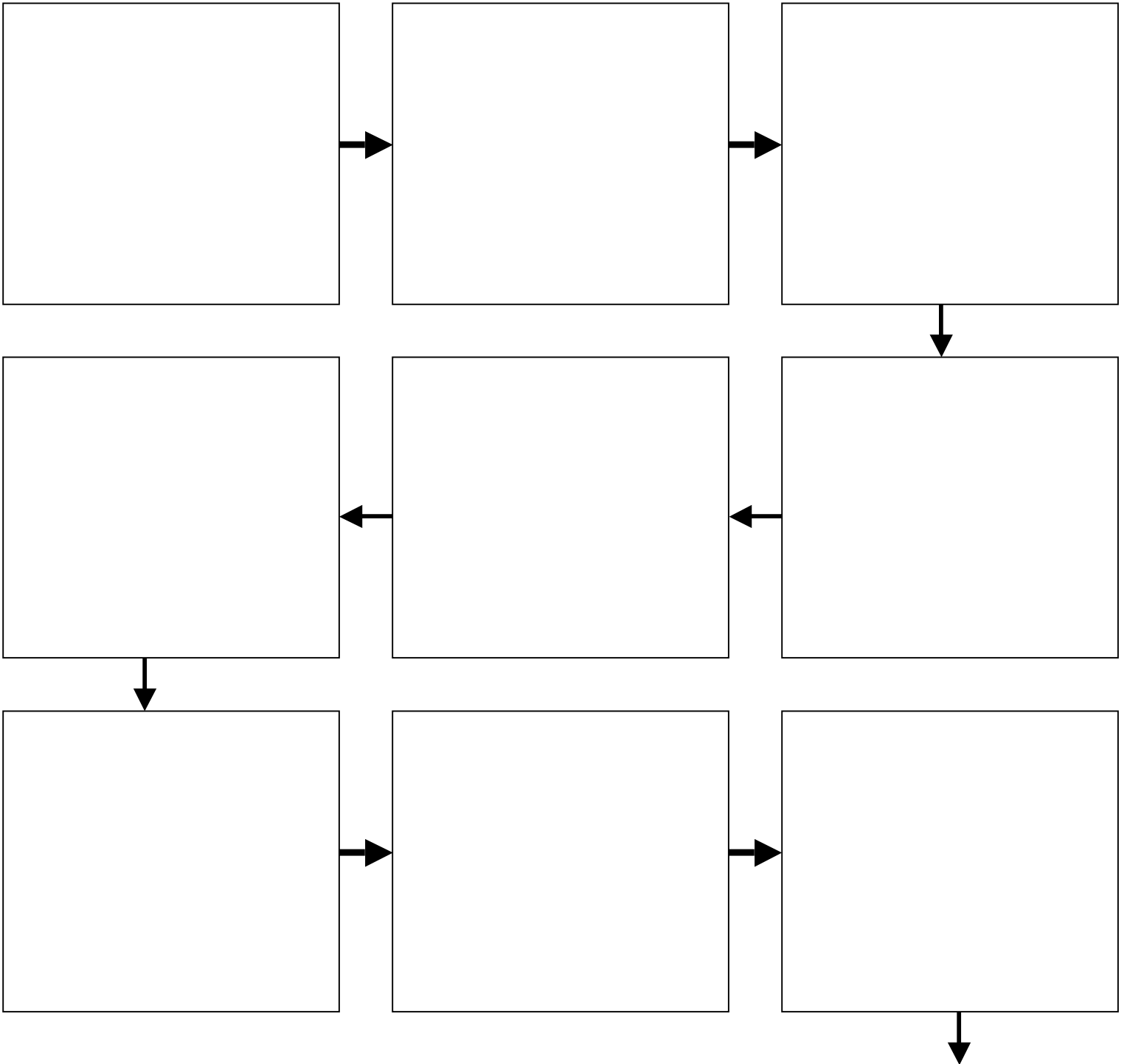
- Create an Olympic Crest. Include on this crest the immortals
 - Greatest personal achievement
 - Parents' greatest achievement
 - Symbols that best represent your immortal
 - Their greatest wish if they were mortal for a day
 - Their greatest failure
 - Three things they wish to be remembered for
- Create a family tree of the god you researched.
- Write some sort of poem that reflects your god's life (acrostic, haiku, limerick, bio-poem, free verse).
- Create a time-line of their life
- Write their Eulogy. A eulogy usually highlights the life of a person, including only their good traits and showing how they tried to make positive contributions to the world.
