GRADUATION CEREMONIES HALF A CENTURY APART

On Tuesday, June 5th, Penn Manor High School said farewell to 453 impressive seniors, which is exactly the number of new PMAA members the association picked up that day! Joining in on the celebration was a small, enthusiastic group of 1962 alumni. The Class of '62 graduated from the same high school building, back then the high school building was home to all students grades 7 through 12. The district had no middle schools in 1962 and the senior class that year included only 199 students.



Although the Class of '62 was relatively small it has seen members inducted into both the Athletic Wall of Honor and the Distinguished Alumni Wall of Honor. In addition, classmates June Finney Rabatin and Eileen Killian wrote the current words to our alma mater over 50 years ago.
