Salute to Career Educators



At this year's alumni banquet we plan to give a dedicated group of alumni a special honor. All Penn Manor alumni who have chosen a career related to the field of education will be saluted. After the banquet dinner we will hold the induction ceremony for this year's entrants to our Distinguished Alumni Wall of Honor. Inductees to be honored are Dr. Daniel C. Witmer, Class of 1956, Dr. Joseph E. McSparran, Class of 1961, and Dr. Dean R. Hess, Class of 1968.

Dr. Daniel C. Witmer graduated from Penn Manor High School in 1956. He earned his B.S. and



his Master's from Millersville University, his Principal's Certificate from Temple University in 1970 and his Ed.D. in 1976 from Penn State University. After serving in the U.S. Army, Dr. Witmer taught science at Manheim Township School District from 1962 until 1970 and later was Assistant Superintendent at Dallastown School District. From 1980 to 1990, he was Superintendent of Schools at Conestoga Valley School District where the special education and arts annex bear his name. Dr. Witmer served as President of the Lancaster Chamber of Commerce from 1990 to 2000. He is a gifted metal sculptor and has been very involved on numerous community boards in the Lancaster area

such as Rotary, United Way, YMCA and Lancaster County Art Association. A scholarship received from the Penn Manor Alumni Association made college possible for him.

Dr. Joseph E. McSparran graduated from Penn Manor High School in 1961. He went on to grad-



uate from West Chester University with a B.S. in Secondary English, earned his Master's in Educational Administration from Fairfield University in Connecticut in 1970 and his Ed.D. in Educational Leadership from the University of Pennsylvania in 1983. Dr. McSparran began his adminstrative career in education in the Manheim Central School District in 1971 as Assistant High School Principal. He served as Supertendent of Schools from 1990 to 1995. From 1996 until the present time, Dr. McSparran has been employed as a professor at Kutztown University. He is a published author. His most recent endeavor is a brochure, "The Other Freshmen Fifteen: Surviving First Semester" for first year college students to help them navi-

gate the critical transition to life on a college campus. In 2010, Dr. McSparran gave the commencement address for Kutztown University.



Dr. Dean R. Hess graduated from Penn Manor High School in 1968. He graduated from Messiah College in 1972, earned his Master's degree from Millersville University in 1980 and his Ph.D. from LaSalle University in 1994. Dr. Hess currently teaches Anesthesia at the Havard Medical School and is Assistant Director of Respiratory Care at Massachusetts General. Dr. Hess has published over 200 papers and 7 books, done extensive medical research and won many prestigious awards such as the Forrest M. Bird Award for Lifetime Scientific Achievement. He has been the Editor-in-Chief of Respiratory Care, the official science journal of the American Association for Respiratory Care since 2008. Dr. Hess has lectured extensively throughout the United States as well as in Europe, Southeast Asia, Africa and South America.

2010 Athletic Wall of Honor Inducted

The eighth class of Penn Manor Athletic Wall of Honor inductees was held on January 14, 2011 prior to Penn Manor's basketball game against Warwick. The recipients were introduced and honored at halftime of the game. This year's class included:

John A. Deibert (Class of 1959) - 1959 Male Athlete of the Year for Penn Manor's senior class. John lettered in basketball (3 years), baseball (3 years) and track (1 year). In basketball, he was a 2nd Team All-County his junior year and a 1st Team All County his senior year. He finished 2nd in scoring in the league his senior year and was Honorable Mention All-State.

Dana (Kern) Brooks (Class of 1963) - Three-sport varsity athlete for three years at Penn Manor. Dana competed in field hockey, basketball and tennis. The Penn Manor field hockey team won the championship Dana's sophomore year. The Penn Manor girls basketball team won championships all three years Dana played where she averaged 20 points per game.

Ronald Hoak (Class of 1965) - Played varsity soccer, wrestling and baseball his sophomore and junior years and soccer and wrestling his senior year. Ron was 1st Team All County in soccer and baseball his junior year. In his senior year Ron was 1st Team All County in soccer and won a Sectional Championship in wrestling at 180 lbs

Alissa (Mowrer) Bradfield (Class of 1991) - Two-sport athlete for Penn Manor from 1988-1991. In field hockey, Alissa was an LL League All-Star in 1990 and her team was PIAA State Runner-Up. She was an LL League All-Star softball player in 1990-91.

Cameron Hollinger (Class of 2003) - Recognized as one of the most successful Pennsylvania high school swimmers in history. Cameron is a seven-time PIAA State High School Swim Champion and was named Male Swimmer of the Meet at States in 2002 and 2003.

David H. Neff


On Thursday, November 18, 2010, PMAA lost a dear friend and long-time financial supporter, Mr. David H. Neff. Dave graduated as a member of the Class of 1937 and over the years won all of PMAA's most prestigious awards. In 1992 he was recognized as our Alumnus of the Year. Then in 1999 he was inducted into the Penn Manor Athletic Wall of Honor. Most recently he received the PMAA President's Award.

Dave served as coach of several Penn Manor varsity sports and was our athletic director for many years. He was married to Sara Ernst Neff (Class of 1939) for 66 years. His lasting memory and his leadership by example will inspire us to keep the alumni association, which he loved, vibrant for many years to come.

Eric M. Torbert, Jr.

At PMAA's 2009 annual banquet the Association honored all Penn Manor alumni who served in the U. S. armed services with an added special tribute to those who lost their lives in service to our country. Now we have another patriotic alumnus who has paid the ultimate price while serving.

On Saturday, December 18, 2010, U.S. Marine Corporal Eric M. Torbert, Jr. died in combat in the Helmand Province of Afghanistan. Eric was the son of Eric M., Sr., and Denise M. Groff Torbert, and the husband of Marcelle L. Sebastian Torbert. Eric graduated from Penn Manor in 2003 and was known as an accomplished guitarist, Little League baseball standout, and a patriotic student. We at PMAA salute Corporal Torbert.





PMAA Senior Awards Program

Your alumni association is proud to sponsor several awards each year for graduating Penn Manor seniors. Each year the Dr. D. L. Biemesderfer Award of \$500 is presented to the class valedictorian and the Mary Klemmer Award of \$500 goes to the salutatorian of the graduating class.
