


LET'S GIVE THEM A CHEER!


PMAA Salutes 40 years of PM Football



On Friday, September 18 approximately 100 Penn Manor football alumni gathered for a special reception at the high school cafeteria honoring them and looking back on 40 years of the Comet football program. Current head coach, Todd Mealy, has written a history of the program in which he recognizes the great contributions by two men who were instrumental in getting this sport on the right track. Coach Bill Beck, who coached Penn Manor's Championship team in 1974, is one of those men. Today Bill still serves as an assistant coach on our program.

The second gentleman who is considered key to the early success and establishment of the sport is long-time athletic director, Coach Dave Neff. As many of you remember, Coach Neff, Penn Manor Class of 1937, won last year's prestigious PMAA President's Award. In spite of his 91 years, Dave still makes it to as many games as possible.

After the reception everyone attended the home football game with Exeter High School at Biemesderfer Stadium. At halftime all returning players were introduced to an enthusiastic crowd. In a fitting tribute to the returning alumni the 2009 Comets team dominated the visitors from Exeter 49-14.
