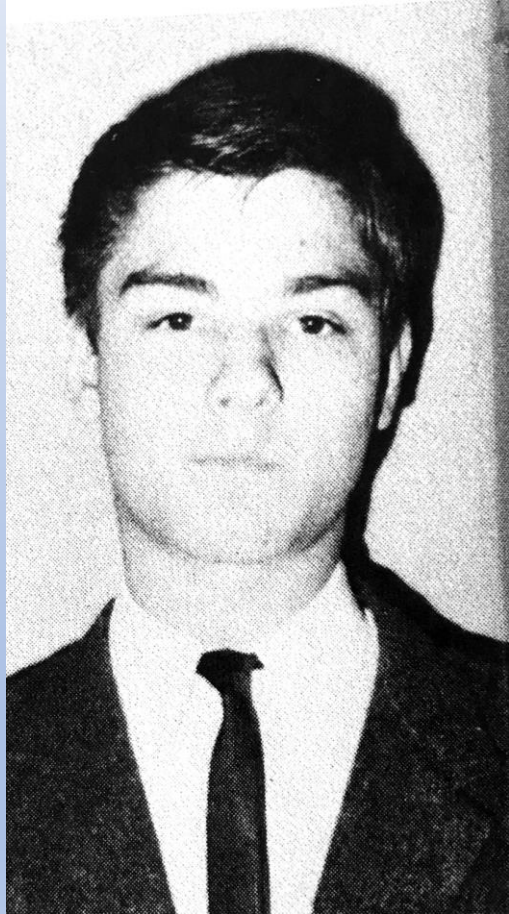

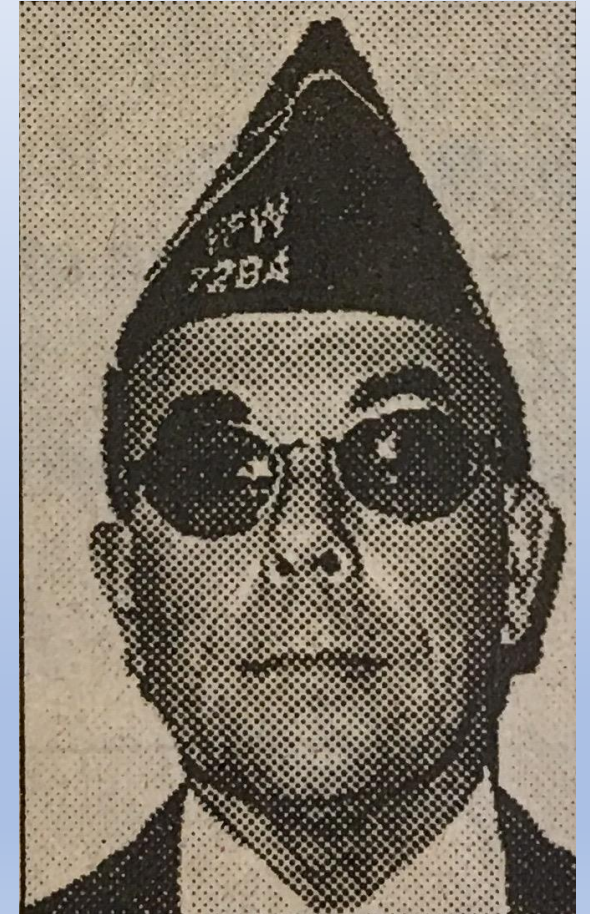


\* In the booklet compiled for our five-year reunion in 1972, Benjamin was listed as deceased. We do not know the exact date of his death.

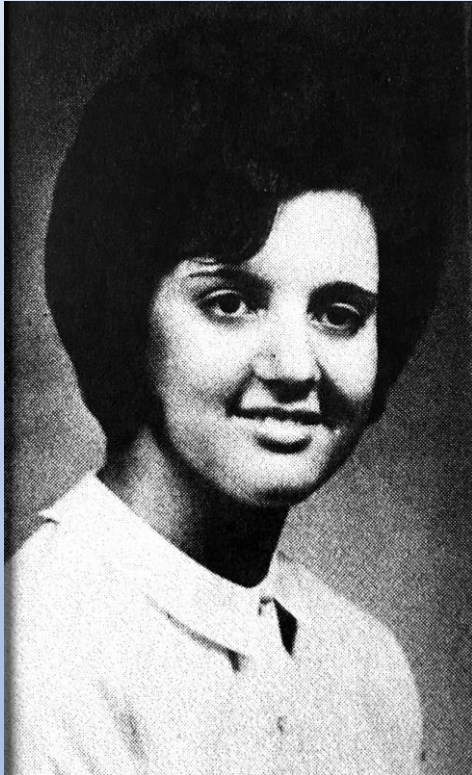

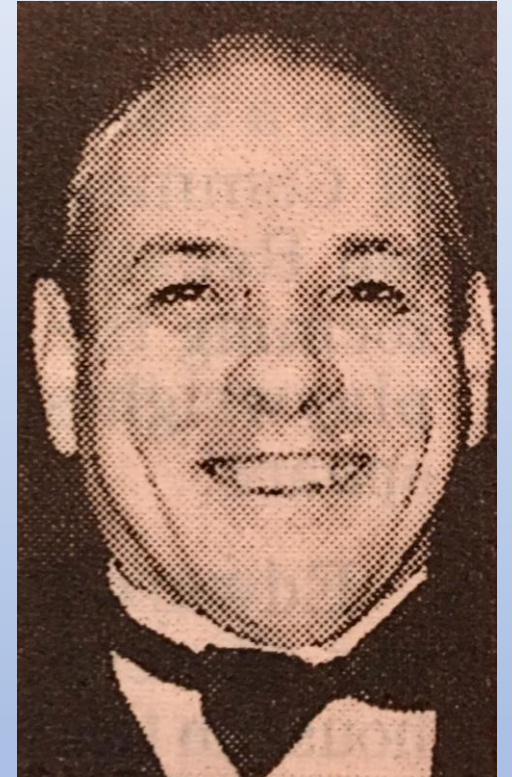




# A. Dean Ressler

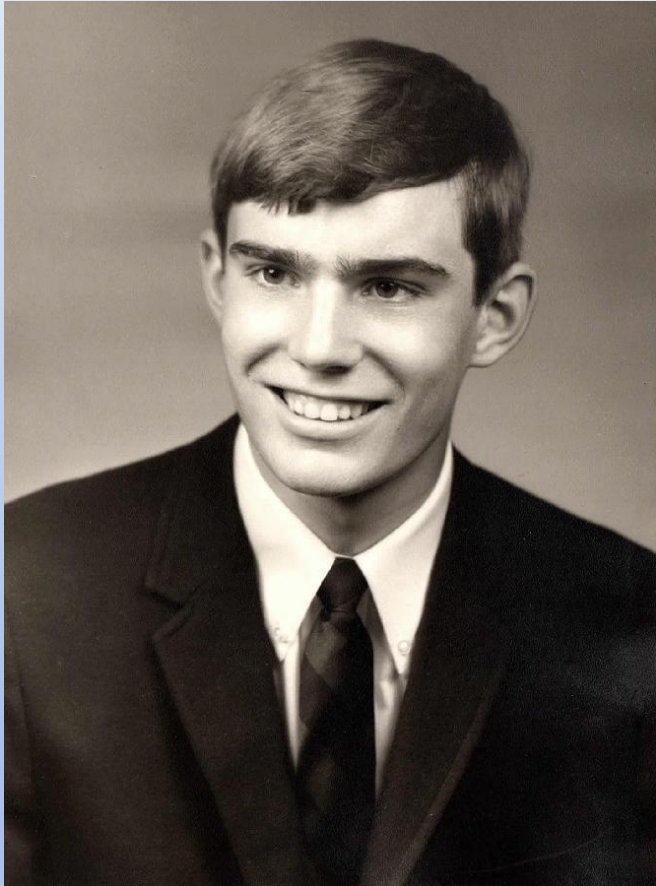

- \* Catcher for fast-pitch softball

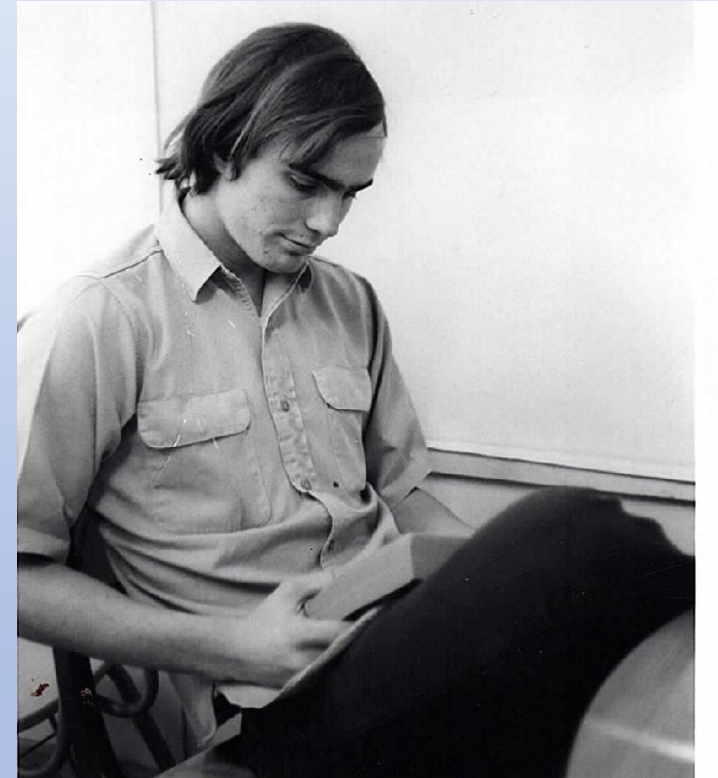

# Patsy A. Troop



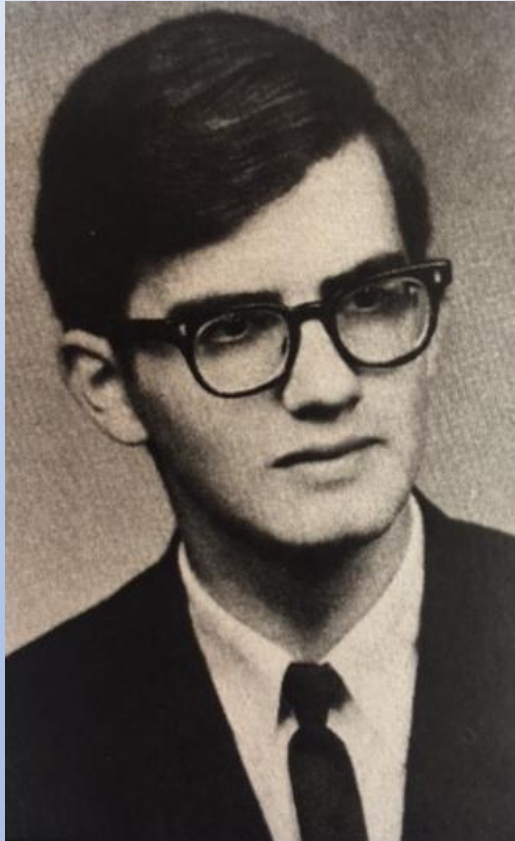
