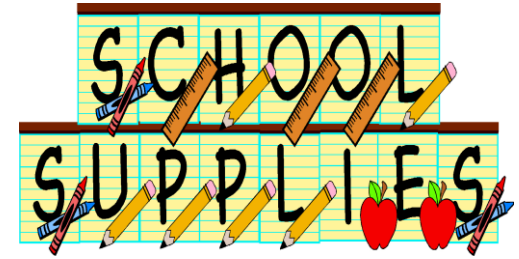
First Day Information:
