- 1. Submit a completed ITS application, code of conduct, as well as PM drug screening form. (Drug forms are only needed if you are not already included on that list.) Code of conduct is needed for each activity Mrs. Mintzer must have one on record for "theatre" whether it's the shows, crew, or club.
- 2. Regularly attend club meetings. We will meet during homeroom every week on Wednesdays. If you consistently miss more than one meeting per month, your name may be removed from our roster.
- 3. Actively, willingly and enthusiastically participate in all club activities!
- 4. Participate in the planning, presentation, and clean up of **TOTS-EAT food drive** (at an October home football game, tentatively). You may also go door-to-door in your own neighborhood on Trick or Treat Night, to gather additional donations. We may also arrange for times to man a table at local grocery stores.
