At Solanco, sophomore LAURA WISSLER earned FIRST place (10 points) in the SHOT PUT with a new personal record of 34' 5.5" Junior SAM ESHLEMAN earned SIXTH place (1 point) with a throw of 28' 7.75" And Karla Mylin just missed finals with her throw of 27' 2.75"

Senior Eddie Irwin was behind Lee in the shot with a new personal record of 40' 2" In the JAVELIN, senior AARON FREDERICK placed FIRST (10 points) with a throw of 162' 10" Senior ERIK KLUGH placed FOURTH (4 points) with a throw of 147' 2" **The Boys Throwers earned 14/102 team points at Solanco.** These are important points as the 2nd place team was just 10 points behind us.

84th SHIPPENSBURG HS INVITATIONAL

While all athletes had to battle the bitter wind and cold, the Shippensburg athletes had to go "neck-and-neck" with former district and state finalists. The competition was intense. Senior Becca Conner threw 31' in the shot put and ended 15th/28 athletes. Becca was originally seeded 27th/28th, so she improved her standing by the end of the meet. Sophomore Sarah Conner ended 19th/28 athletes. The winning throw was over 38'!

In the discus, junior Sarah Conner just missed finals with her throw of 99' 4" Sarah was originally seeded 17th/26 qualifying athletes, but she improved her performance and finished 10th/26. Senior/co-captain CARENNA NEELY placed 7th (2 points) with a throw of 105' 7" Junior HELEN DOOLITTLE placed 4th (5 points) with a new personal record of 110' 5" The winning throw was over 130'!
