

Vaccines for Kids

Free Childhood Immunizations for Eligible Children



Penn Medicine Lancaster General Health offers vaccines for children who do not have health insurance or who have Medicaid (Medical Assistance) and who are 0 – 18 years old. Vaccines against chicken pox, tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis, Hib, Hepatitis A + B, HPV, influenza, measles, mumps, rubella, meningitis, pneumococcal disease, polio, rotavirus, and COVID-19 will be available.

Appointments recommended; Walk-ins accepted. Call 717-696-9685 for appointments or questions.

Program requirements:

- Children 0 18 years of age
- Only for uninsured children or those with Medicaid. No CHIP plans accepted
- · A parent or guardian must accompany the child

You must bring the child's up-to-date vaccine record to receive vaccines.
