Is Dual Enrollment Right for me?



Benefits

- Get college credits done early, credits will transfer to many schools
- Save money MU, HACC, and LBC
- Experience a college course
- Will count for high school elective credit*

Requirements

- Have exhausted most academically challenging coursework offered at PM
 - Examples: Math, Spanish etc.
- Elective
- Most schools need SAT/ACT scores or placement test.

Should I consider online courses?

Benefit:

- Flexibility for class schedule

Considerations:

- Not immediate communications/feedback with professors
- Computer and internet access
- Your Characteristics (motivated, organized and dedicated)

Allow for 9.6 or more hours per week of work for each course

Application Procedures (Purple and Green Form)



1. Find a permitted course that fits your schedule.
2. Fill out the appropriate forms completely
3. Request Transcripts to be sent through Career Cruising.
4. Submit the forms to your counselor.

HACC Procedures

1. Turn into your counselor the following:

- a. Dual Enrollment Paper Application
- b. Enrollment Form to Register for Credit Courses
- c. Transcript

2. Placement Testing

If you have taken SAT or ACT, include a copy of the score report with the Application. Scores can also be email to HACC's Admissions Counselor from your College Board account.

3. Pay Tuition and Fees

4. Give your counselor a copy of course schedule to show proof you are enrolled.

Dual Enrollment at HACC

Enrollment Process

Complete the Application for Admission: College Programs for High School Students

Applications are available at your high school counseling office or directly from your HACC Admissions Counselor*.

(Note: Application requires student, parent/guardian, and school counselor/principal signature to be processed.)

High School Transcripts

Submit a copy of your high school transcript with your application.

(Note: Application must include a copy of your high school transcript in order to be processed.)

SAT and ACT Scores (if applicable for student)

If you have taken the SAT or ACT, include a copy of the score report with your application.

(Note: Scores may be used to determine possible exemption from HACC's placement testing.)

TEST	SCORE	EXEMPTION
SAT/ACT Reading	480 or above/18 or higher	Reading Placement Test
SAT/ACT Writing	480 or above/21 or higher	Writing Placement Test
SAT/ACT Math	550 or above/23 or higher	Math Placement Test

Submit a copy of your class registration form

Registration forms are available at your high school counseling office, or directly from your HACC Admissions Counselor*.

(Note: If you know the classes in which you'd like to enroll, submit this form along with your application. If not, you may submit the registration form after placement testing is completed.)

Confirmation Email

After the application has been processed, a confirmation email will be sent to the email address you provided on your application, followed by a second email with your "myhacc" log-in information.

Placement Testing visit www.hacc.edu/placement

Your admissions counselor* will notify you via email if placement testing is required.

If placement testing is required, bring a photo ID to HACC's Lancaster Campus during the following days and times (no appointment is necessary):

Mondays and Fridays, between 9AM and 2PM

Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays, between 9AM and 6PM

Enter the Main building, sign-in at the Welcome Center, and staff will direct you to the Testing Center.

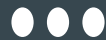

Millersville Procedures

1. **Apply online**
 - a. Choose Class
 - b. Upload Transcript
 - c. Upload SAT or ACT Scores
2. **Turn into your Penn Manor Counselor the packet that includes:**
 - a. Penn Manor High School Dual Enrollment Application
 - b. Millersville Transcript Release form
3. *Call to schedule placement tests or make sure to have AP Scores sent to Millersville
4. **Give your counselor proof you are enrolled in the class**
5. **Attend Orientation**

Special Note:

****We encourage students to fill out the transcript request form at the point of application, so that at the end of the semester, MU automatically sends your official transcript. There's a link on the dual enrollment website:**

MU Steps to Apply for Dual Enrollment Courses

- Use the URL address on the blue Dual Enrollment Checklist under “If Applying to Millersville”

- 1) Dual Enrollment Transcript Release Form
- 2) View Spring 2019 approved course list
- 3) Spring 2019 Application

- Students must select courses from the approved course list, available on the admissions website.
Students should only apply for courses they wish to enroll in. Millersville will no longer request first, second and third choices; we will do our best to honor the course(s) you wish to take
 - *We recommend that students apply for fall classes no later than May 15th, and spring classes no later than November 15th, for best placement opportunities*

Applications for dual enrollment courses should be submitted to Millersville by **May 15th** to ensure greatest consideration for placement.

Credit at Penn Manor:

1. You must provide your counselor proof you are enrolled in a class at a college
 - a. Copy of your schedule, or copy of payment or screenshot of your online schedule

2. You must provide your counselor with your final grade to ensure you get the grade on your semester report card and transcript.

If you do not submit the forms through the counseling office, it may not count as Penn Manor credit!
