Rules: Entrants are asked to take pictures that illustrate one of the ten tenants of the

Optimist Creed. Each entrant may submit up to three (3) photos. Photos may be black-and-white or color. If a digital camera is used, the submitted photo may not be 'photo-shopped' other than cropping, or the sort of adjustment for brightness, contrast, etc. that a film photographer might do in the darkroom. Photo must be 4x6 up to an 8x10 and mounted. On the back of the photo the entry form must be placed. The line of the Creed being illustrated needs to be on the front under the picture. Only photos taken in the current school year may

he used. NO NAME ON FRONT OF PHOTO.

Judging: The photographs will be judged based on the artistic quality of the photo as well

as its illustration of the topic. The best three (3) photographs will be selected for

submission as entries in the Atlantic Central District Contest.

Awards: First, Second, and Third place certificates of participation and prize money will

be awarded.
